It is a generic standard that can be applied to any industry, regardless of the product or service delivered. The standard refers to an organization's structure for managing the

processes or activities that transform inputs of resources into a product or service to meet customized objectives, such as satisfying customer quality requirements.

The International Organization for Standardization was established in 1947 with the mission of contributing to economic and social progress.
